## FURTHER SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

*The meeting shall be known as the 2017 Queensland Circuit Racing State Championships - Round 1 and shall be of State Championship status held under the current FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd. (CAMS), the 2017 Race Meeting Standing Regulations, the 2017 Queensland Circuit Racing State Championships Sporting Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any further regulations, Bulletins or instructions as issued. **Saturday (20/05/17):** from 7:00am  
**Sunday (21/05/17):** from 7:30am as required

**NOTE:** Target Scrutiny will be available / Scrutiny will take place in the Scrutiny Bay in order of arrival.

### 4. OBSERVED LICENCE TEST

Drivers requiring observation please report to the office of the Secretary of the Meeting after document check and advise the Clerk of Course of your name, car number and category. After qualifying take your time sheet to the Clerk of Course so that your licence may be endorsed.

### 5. PROVISIONAL LICENCE HOLDERS

It is your responsibility to leave your licence with the Secretary of the Meeting, who will forward it to the Clerk of Course for endorsement towards your Clubman Circuit or National Circuit licence.

### 6. SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATION AMENDMENTS

Paragraph 4 (a) of the Supplementary Regulations for this event shall read:

- a. The Meeting shall be known as the *2017 Queensland Circuit Racing State Championships - Round 1*

Paragraph 4 (b) of the Supplementary Regulations for this event shall read:

- b. Entries shall be restricted to First Category Racing Cars including Formula Ford, Formula Vee and Formula 3; 2<sup>nd</sup> Category Groups 2A, 2B, 2C, 2F & 2I; 3<sup>rd</sup> Category Groups 3D, 3E, 3H, 3J including Queensland Geminis & 3K Saloon Cars. 5<sup>th</sup> Category Historic Touring Cars Group N, Racing & Sports Cars Groups M, O, P, Q & R; Sports Cars Groups S & T; 6<sup>th</sup> Category Sports Cars.

Paragraph 9 (c) of the Supplementary Regulations for this event shall read:

- c. A letter of Authority MUST be shown at Document Check for any vehicle where the owner does NOT hold a current CAMS licence.

Paragraph 11 of the Supplementary Regulations for this event shall read:

- a. A **compulsory Driver's Briefing** shall be held Saturday May 20, 2017 at 8:00am at the Pit Lane Grand Stand.
- b. Failing to attend and/or signing the attendance sheets shall incur a penalty in accordance with Paragraph 9.4 of the 2017 Race Meeting Standing Regulations.

Paragraph 14 of the Supplementary Regulations for this event shall read:

#### **14. RACING**

- a. **All Classes EXCLUDING Sports Sedans:** Cars for scratch races will assemble in the numbered bays in the marshalling area. A 1 minute board will be shown in the Marshalling Area and cars will move onto the circuit for one (1) formation lap before taking up their allocated position for a massed grid start. The starter will indicate approximately 5 seconds before the red lights are switched on. At a time between 3 and 5 seconds after the red light is shown, the start of the race will be indicated by the extinguishment of the red lights. **A green light will not be shown.**
- b. **Sports Sedans** shall assemble in the numbered bays in the marshalling area. A 1 minute board will be shown in the Marshalling Area and cars will move onto the circuit for one (1) formation lap behind the Safety Car. At the end of the Formation Lap the Safety Car will enter Pit Lane where the field will be started by way of a GREEN FLAG.
- c. Grid Determination for Race 1 shall be by qualifying times, fastest to slowest. Subsequent races are based on a progressive grid, based on the finishing order of the previous race.
- d. NO unauthorised person is permitted on the competition side of the red line as marked in Pit Lane.

#### **7. CODE OF DRIVING CONDUCT**

**Competitors are reminded** of Article 7 of the Race Meeting Standing Regulations in the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and should be aware the Clerk of Course has the authority to impose **a pit lane drive through penalty** and or **time penalties** for any perceived breaches.

#### **8. GENERAL**

All COMPETITORS in all CLASSES are reminded that all cars must comply with the provisions of **Schedule K (Markings on Automobiles)** competition numbers under the General Requirements in the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
