

# 2017 CAMS Australian Super Sprint Championship

## Morgan Park Raceway

### Saturday November 18<sup>th</sup> 2017 & Sunday November 19<sup>th</sup> 2017

This Championship will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Limited (CAMS), the Speed Event Standings Regulations, Australian Super Sprint Championship Regulations, Supplementary Regulations and Further Regulations.

#### 4. ELIGIBLE COMPETITORS:

- a. **Vehicle Requirements:** All vehicles must comply with Schedules A and B and 5th Category – Historic Cars Vehicle Eligibility (where applicable) of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
- b. Each occupant of an automobile must comply with the requirements of apparel for that competition. Any non-compliant apparel may be impounded by the Organiser for the duration of that Meeting – in accordance with NCR 141.

#### 5. ENTRIES:

- a. Entry Fee is \$220.00 – this includes transponder hire for the weekend.

- d. Paper Entries must be **EXPRESS POSTED** to PO Box 1452, Beenleigh 4207 to ensure it arrives on time.
- e. Competitors are responsible for completing their Entry Forms correctly and in full. It is the responsibility of the competitor to allocate which class they are in, based on the classes outlined in the Supplementary Regulations (*Section 20 – Classes*). If competitors do not allocate a class, they will be placed into a class as instructed by the Scrutineering Team.
- f. **No refunds** will be issued once your entry has been lodged.
- g. Entries will open on publication of these Supplementary Regulations.
- h. Entries will be capped at 150 entries.

## 6. EVENT:

Proceedings for this event will be as follows:

- a. Saturday competition commences at approximately 8:30am and will conclude at approximately 5:00pm
- b. Sunday competition commences at approximately 8:00am and will conclude at approximately 4:00pm

In accordance with the **Speed Event Standing Regulations** and **NCR 24B**, starting procedure will be as follows:

- a. Cars will be called to the Marshalling Area / Dummy Grid
- NOTE:** All drivers MUST be dressed in their race apparel before departing the marshalling area to Pit Exit
- b. Cars will be released to Pit Exit
  - c. Cars are released from Pit Exit
  - d. Cars will be stopped on the grid in groups of two
  - e. Cars will be released a maximum of two at a time in accordance with NCR 24B

### Saturday

Circuit K (3km) will be used (3 Laps) –3 runs will be allocated for Track K.

### Sunday

Circuit E (2.1km) will be used (4 Laps) –3 runs will be allocated for Track E

**Final Winner** will be decided by the competitors fastest lap time on Circuit K added to their fastest lap time on Circuit E

## 7. PRIVATE PRACTICE (FRIDAY 17<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER, 2017)

Private practice will be held on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> November, 2017. Information regarding these sessions is as follows:

- a. Commencing at approximately 9:00am
- b. Concluding approximately 5:00pm
- c. Cost is \$50.00
- d. Practice groups to be advised Friday Morning, 17<sup>th</sup> November 2017 prior to commencement of Practice
- e. Running of the Tracks are as follows:
  - i. 9:00am – 11:45am: Circuit E
  - ii. 12:15pm – 5:00pm: Circuit K

## 8. GROUPS:

- a. will be 8

- b. Groups will be allocated and published **one week** in advance to competitors for knowledge on the Morgan Park website [www.morganparkraceway.com.au](http://www.morganparkraceway.com.au) and via email (emails will be used that were provided upon entry – please ensure you use the correct email address)

#### **9. LICENCES:**

- a. **Drivers** competing in the sprints must hold a minimum of a current CAMS Speed (Level 2S) Competition Licence.
- b. **No Licences available at the track.**
- c. **All drivers** must have proof of current membership of a CAMS affiliated Club which must be presented at Scrutiny AND Document Check.
- d. All Licences, CAMS pass books, competition records, log books, COD's and membership cards must be presented at Scrutiny and also be available if required for inspection at any other time during the course of the Event.

#### **10. VEHICLE NUMBERS:**

- a. Competitors will be issued with a number at allocation of groups and run order (to be published with Further Regulations. Numbers are to be positioned at the top left corner of the windscreen for vehicles with windscreens.
- b. Vehicles without windscreens must affix the number in a forward-facing position on the left-hand front of the car.
- c. This number must be clearly visible to the timekeepers.

#### **11. SCRUTINEERING:**

Cars will be checked to Safety and General Compliance with these Regulations. Compulsory scrutineering will take place on the Friday afternoon between 2:00pm and 4:00pm, and on the Saturday morning from 7:00am or by arrangement for after 8:00am.

**Scrutineering will not be completed if you do not have your paperwork from Document Check.**

**The following documents must be presented at Scrutineering:**

- Current CAMS Vehicle Log Book – MUST be presented for those vehicles that have been issued one.
- CAMS Certificate of Description (5<sup>th</sup> Category only) – other than Group N & S

**Vehicles that have current vehicle road registration in Queensland** under the "Transport Operations (Road Use Management – Vehicle Registration) Regulation 1999" MUST present their Compulsory Third Party (CTP) insurance for the duration of the meeting. If this is not provided, you will not be permitted to compete.

#### **12. DOCUMENT CHECK:**

- a. Document check will begin on **Friday the 17<sup>th</sup> November at approximately 9:00am and close at approximately 4:00pm** in the Secretary's Office on the bottom floor of the pit lane tower. Document check will commence Saturday at 7:00am – 7:45am or by arrangement after 7:45am.
- b. ALL drivers must present their CAMS Competition Licence, current CAMS club membership, CAMS Vehicle Log Book for those cars that have one issued, and for Queensland Road Registered your Compulsory Third Party (CTP) Insurance Letter.

*A Letter of Authorisation* MUST be given to the Secretary of the Meeting if competing in an entered vehicle that is not owned by the competitor. This will be verified through the name of ownership on the Vehicle Logbook, the name on the CTP letter (NOTE: if you have a car insured in the company name, then you will require a letter stating permission to compete in the entered vehicle).

### 13. TIMING:

- a. The "My Laps" electronic timing system will be used.
- b. All competitors will be supplied with a timing transponder at each round which is included in the entry fee. A \$100 cash or credit card deposit will be required for the transponder at each round.
- c. Times will be posted on the bottom floor of the pit lane tower for viewing, and will also be uploaded to My Laps website at the end of competition each day.
- d. Paper copies are not to be taken from the office. Please provide your email address to the Secretary of the Meeting if you wish to have your times emailed after each group's run.

### 14. RE-RUNS:

- a. Re-runs will only be allowed when the official timing gear fails or the track is being blocked by a spinning or broken down car.
- b. All re-runs will be granted at the discretion of the "Clerk of Course" only.
- c. Re-runs will not be granted to competitors who spin or cause another car to slow down. Re-runs will not be granted for any other reason.
- d. Make up runs will not be granted to any competitor who arrives late or has a mechanical problem.

### 15. PENALTIES:

A 5 second penalty will be added to a competitor's time for each occasion for the following:

- Shortening the course (1 or more wheels over the kerb)
- Departing from the course
- Rolling Start / Jump Start (This will be at the judgement of the Starter, Clerk of Course, and Chief Timekeeper)

The competition surface of the track is defined by the white line.

Burnouts of any sort will result in immediate disqualification from the event.

**NO Drifting of any sort permitted** – any sort of drifting will result in immediate disqualification from the event.

### 16. DRIVER'S BRIEFING:

A compulsory Driver's Briefing will be held on the Saturday morning before competition commences. **This briefing will be held at 8:00am sharp in the Pit Lane Grand Stand** and will be delivered by the Clerk of Course. There will be attendance sheets to sign at the briefing. Please sign on **before the commencement** of the briefing. Failure to attend or sign on at the briefing shall incur penalty. Additional briefings may be held at the judgement of the Clerk of Course.

### 17. PROTESTS:

Any protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS National Competition Rules (NCR's).

## 18. ALCOHOL / DRUGS:

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS. Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

## 19. ABANDONMENT, POSTPONEMENT & CANCELLATION:

The Organisers reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel the meeting at their discretion (NCR 59).

**Slick tyres are not permitted for Improved Production classes.** If you have slick tyres, you will be moved into Sports Sedans by Scruitneering, Secretary of the Meeting, Clerk of Course and Timing.

## 21. GENERAL:

- a. **CAMPING is allowed for competitors** along the East side fence and North end of the Main Pit area, but note there is no power close to these areas. Cost is \$22 per site per day for powered sites, payable to the WDSCC circuit organisers on the weekend.
- b. **Car Garage** hire fee is \$88.00 (incl. GST), payable to WDSCC organisers on the weekend – this **MUST** be organised with the Treasurer **PRIOR** to the event as the garages are limited; Email the following email to organise [treasurer@morganparkraceway.com.au](mailto:treasurer@morganparkraceway.com.au).
- c. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au)
- d. Pit lane speed limit shall be 40kph
- e. Paddock speed limit shall be 10kph
- f. Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. **Fuel will not be available at the circuit**
- g. **ALL TRAILERS** should be parked in the “Trailer Park” on the left-hand side of the entry road to the Paddock Area, or as directed by an appointed official.
- h. Entrants will be required to pay for the servicing of any fire extinguishers used on their vehicle.
- i. There is to be **no smoking in the pits at any time** throughout the course of the weekend.
- j. ALL tender vehicles and/or personal vehicles are not permitted to enter the race areas, i.e. Marshalling or Pit Lane, until all events have been completed for the day.
